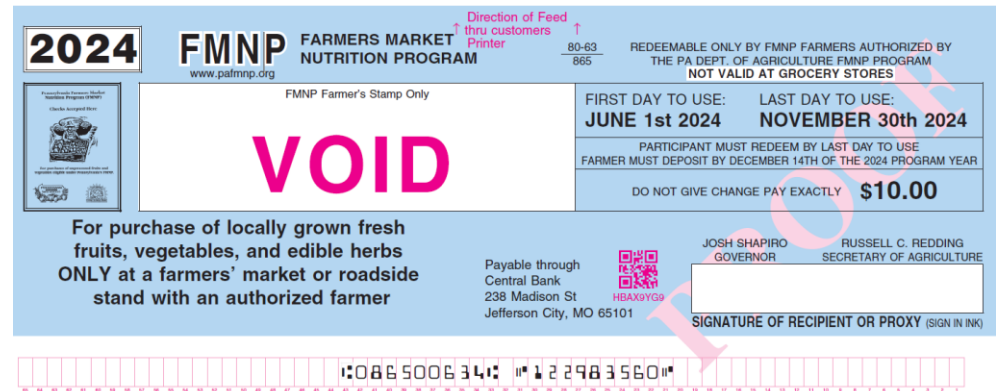

	Fruit & Vegetable Dollars on eWIC Card	Pennsylvania Farmers' Market Checks
Where to use?	Any WIC authorized grocery store. Locate WIC authorized grocery stores by visiting the WIC Shopper app or www.pawic.com .	Any local farmers' market in Pennsylvania that accepts the checks. Locate farmers' markets by visiting the PA FMNP Market Locator app or www.pafmnp.pa.gov .
When to use?	First of the month through last day of the month.	From June 1st through November 30th
What can I buy?	Any fruit and vegetable that is allowed on the current WIC food list. For example, citrus fruits and bananas are allowed.	Any fresh fruits, vegetables or cut herbs <u>grown in</u> Pennsylvania. Ask the farmer if their produce has been grown in Pennsylvania and not a neighboring state.
What not to buy?	Any item that is not allowed on the current WIC Food List	Fruits or vegetables that are not grown in Pennsylvania, such as citrus or other tropical fruits like bananas. Other items at farmer markets are not allowed, such as baked goods, jams and jellies.
Customer will pay the difference if purchase exceeds amount on eWIC card or farmers' market check(s). When using farmers' market checks, change will not be provided if full amount is not used.
